# Fundraising Update (C. Calabrese)

- Current fundraising initiatives:
  - o FlipGive Up and running
    - Approximately \$35 raised this school year already
  - Domino's Pizza First event scheduled for November 10th
- C. Calabrese proposed options for new fundraising initiatives:
  - o Recipe Jars:
    - free shipping to customers if 6+ jars ordered. If only 1→5 jars are ordered then a flat fee for shipping applies.
    - V. Frantellizzi mentioned that the 'Recipe Jars' didn't do well at her previous school.
    - No votes in favour from any School Council members to proceed with this initiative

## Laura Secord Chocolate bars

- boxes can be shipped directly to customers' houses.
- school would need to make a commitment up-front of selling a large amount of boxes.
- T. Rossi asked if possible we can have 1-box per classroom & parents who just want a few bars can purchase from that box.
- N. Edwards mentioned selling chocolate bars may be more challenging due to some parents still working from home
- School Council members voted in favour = T. Rossi, Y. Annobil, A. Bruney-Francis

## Terra Cotta Cookies:

- frozen dough balls.
- No option of shipping directly to customers' home

# Big Box Fundraising:

- greeting cards. \$33-per box, where all boxes are shipped to the school. Or \$35-per box to ship
  each direct to customers' home. The company rep mentioned that all schools except one are having
  them delivered to the school.
- Mrs. Linardic received a response during this meeting that Merici can have these delivered to the school since we can just give them to students to bring home instead of parents coming into school building. Or do curbside pickup, with School Council members being the only outside staff/students allowed into the school building.
- School Council members voted in favour = C. Calabrese, T. Rossi, Mrs. Benedik, A. Bruney-Francis, A. Adeniyi, Y. Annobil, N. Edwards
- C. Calabrese asked when to start card fundraiser, & Mrs. Linardic proposed start late February when there's a break in school activities

## Pajama Day:

- maybe 1-Friday a month
- participants pay a small amt in-order to participate; maybe \$1-each

## o FunDrive:

- like a donation program for items such as clothing, housewares, books, media, etc.
- Collect items for a designated period of time & then School Council would need to find a way to
  deliver to a Value Village where they will weigh it & write a cheque for the school. Varying value
  dependent on items. For example: clothing/linen = \$0.15 per pound. Housewares/electronics =
  \$0.10 per pound, books/media = \$0.02-each
- A. Valente proposed getting t-shirts made with school logo & mascot (etc.) & sell
  - Mrs. Linardic reminded all that we do have school spirit wear which is sold once a year & has school name & mascot on it
  - V. Frantellizzi proposed asking teachers what their initiatives are so we get that on t-shirts instead, or have students design a shirt. Then showed us an example of a shirt her school is doing
    - Mrs. Linardic said this is done with graduating class where students compete by submitting their own design & then a winner is picked
    - T. Rossi proposed maybe the School Council can subsidize part or full cost of t-shirts with initiative phrase on it.
    - Mrs. Linardic will look into the cost of t-shirts from School Board approved vendors. As well will ask teachers/staff what initiatives they would like printed on the t-shirts
- V. Frantellizzi asked we remember to be sensitive about families who cannot afford participating in some fundraisers; such as Pajama Day where students may feel left out, or feel pressured to purchase chocolates.

• C. Calabrese explained that many of these vendors are booked until the new year so any new fundraising ideas would be for January or beyond.

## **Other Items**

- Mrs. Linardic asked for feedback on newsletter blast now on a link instead of PDF. Many in favour. C. Calabrese requested to have fundraising sent via a separate email, so it's eye-catching for recipients & not lost in the newsletter.
- C. Calabrese will be resending 'Save The Date' calendar invites for all future School Council meetings to correct the hosting email they were originally sent from.
- C. Calabrese won't be able to attend the next School Council meeting on Dec. 2nd, therefore will reach out to other School Council members to see who will be able to host that meeting.
