Fundraising Update

- FlipGive Approximately \$62 raised this school year (sales ending Nov 22nd, 2021)
- Domino's Pizza First dough raising event scheduled for November 10th generated \$450. Next event TBD
- Big Box Card Fundraiser Approved by council for February 2022 execution
 - Cost Changes:

Current Card Box Cost: \$22 moving to \$24

Current Card Box Retail: \$33 moving to \$35

\$2 cost/retail increase

Profit remains the same: \$11 per box/ 31%

- Timing/Dates:
 - Flyers and support materials arrive at the school: Wed. February 16th
 - Campaign launches, and video and parent letter and announcement flyers go home with the families on Tues. February 22nd
 - Event ends/orders come in by Mon. March 7th
- Prizes, (provided by Big Box):
 - A 32 GB Apple iPod Touch or an 8 inch Samsung tablet "A" if the school sells over 400-boxes in total
 - 4 X \$25 gift cards top retailers if the school sells 150-boxes or more
 - 2 X \$25 gift cards top retailers if the school sells 75-boxes or more

Other Items

- Mrs. Linardic mentioned that the School Board has come back & said School Council members are actually not allowed in the school building to help out with BigBox fundraiser as previously informed.
 - o Mrs. Cunningham & her grade 8 class has volunteered to step in & organize this BigBox card fundraiser
- V. Frantellizzi mentioned (Merici) school should be speaking more (advertising) how DPCDSB is praised for Indigenous activities done & still doing. (Like individuals who have been Indigenous reps & have done presentations with Merici school).
- spirit wear for special event
 - o school staff said "Identity" topic for embroidery
 - o approx. 450-students & staff but Mrs. Linardic will confirm to make sure includes online students
 - o tshirt pricing approx. $\$6 \rightarrow \7 -ea, or can get toques to avoid different sizing issues, or plastic water bottles \$2.30+tx
 - all can have "Merici" also printed/embroidered on product
 - V. Frantellizzi likes tshirt idea as can be used all year round, but toques only worn during winter months & may only be Feb/Mar this school year
 - T. Rossi asked if teachers can get sizes while in class & control that small number, or have parents fill out survey form to indicate size for each student
 - C. Ferrari pointed out that toques may end up in lost & found due to everyone has same toque; likes tshirt for Spring time to give us time to get sizes
 - give students chance to submit design/drawing
 - C. Ferrari volunteered to work with Mme. Deveauz-Matthews to get blurb to send to students of what is required for contest of design/ drawing on
 - Ferrari will try to get Isaac (one of the Indigenous reps used in past for various Indigenous activities) to help do video presentation to then present to school students for guidance on design/drawing submissions
 - o In favour of tshirts: A. Valente, R. Uokuoma, V. Frantellizzi, A. Bruney-Francis
 - Rossi to allocate \$3200 to include for all needing tshirts
